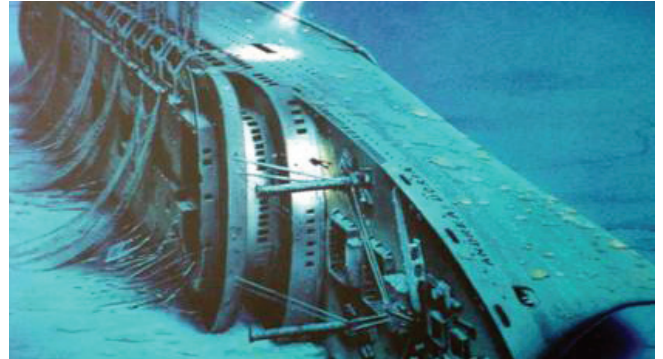


Andrea Doria:

THE DIVING

Come dive the flagship of the Italian fleet, the Andrea Doria, with Indian Valley Scuba! The ship sits in 235 ft of water in one of the most treacherous areas of the shipping lanes off the coast of Nantucket. She sank after a collision with the Stockholm in 1956 becoming the most famous shipwreck of our time next to the Titanic. For more than 50 years hearty divers have been visiting this site which has been the subject of more than six books, hundreds of articles and has made more than a few divers famous in their own right. The Andrea Doria was the proving grounds for early technical diving and is still the "Mount Everest of Dives". This is the technical diving trip so many dream of making – log yours this year!

Indian Valley Scuba's tech trips are first class from mixing gas to surfacing from the last deco stop. We specialize in keeping our trips small and ensuring a great time and safe experience for all. By using one of the best boats and most experienced crews on Long Island, our divers are assured a most memorable experience. We keep our trips small and only crew them with the best possible crews on the best possible vessels to make your dive experience a memorable one to remember for years!

We'll board the RV Garloo on Friday evening for a 7:00 p.m. departure, and make the 16 hour overnight run to the site. Once the crew of the Garloo have us tied in, we plan to stay until mid-day Sunday, allowing each diver to plan his or her dives to their own personal comfort level. Do as many or as few dives as you wish, there is no pressure or limits on your diving. We'll un-hook at 3:00 on Sunday, and make it back to the dock by 8:00 a.m. Monday morning.

And of course technical training options are available to our divers on this trip. Contact the shop to see how we can work your class schedule prior to this adventure. Rebreathers are welcome on this trip also.

Due to the location of the wreck weather often plays a role in affecting a decision to safely conduct our dives. As a result, we have included Trip Cancellation insurance in the charter price at no additional cost.

The Garloo has five cabins, double occupancy. Participants need to bring a sleeping bag and pillow, plus towels and any other personal items. Equipment, tanks, gas & fills are not included but rentals can be arranged ahead of time and delivered to the boat by Indian Valley Scuba. No rental gear is available on board.

For those less familiar with this wreck, the depths are approx. 170 to 250 ft. The debris field sits at 220 ft. Each open circuit diver needs to bring 4 sets of double tanks for their primary gas, plus deco mixes. Air top-offs are available on board. Typical open circuit gas blends in the 18-19% O₂/30-50% He are the most common; however, each diver is responsible for their own dive planning and gas blends. Typical run times are in the range of 20-35 minutes of bottom time.
